What is Sapporo City Seiyukan Junior High School ?

There are people who are over the age of compulsory education (15 years old), regardless of nationality, who could not graduate from junior high school for various reasons, or who were not able to learn enough due to reasons such as attendance.

In order for such people to gain a junior high school level of education, Sapporo Seiyukan Junior High School is the first public night junior high school established in Hokkaido.



Educational goals

We aim to be a school that respects diversity so that all students can feel at ease and play a leading role in their learning.



Admission qualification

All of the following conditions must be met:

- (1) Those who are over the age of compulsory education (15 years old).
- (2) Those who have not graduated from junior high school, or those who have graduated but have not been able to fully study due to reasons such as issues with attendance (regardless of nationality).
- (3) Those who live in Sapporo City and municipalities that cooperate with Sapporo City.

Expenses

- There is no tuition fee. You can get the textbooks for free.
- About 500 yen a month is required for school life, as teaching materials and paper costs. There is also a school lunch fee. Event fees occasionally may be required.
- There is a system for support school attendance. Please consult with Seiyukan Junior High School.



The school day, learning time

- We study on weekday nights. (From 5:30 pm to 9:10 pm)
- We study 5 days a week.(4 hours a day, 20 hours a week) Holidays are the same as daytime at junior high schools in Sapporo, such as summer vacation and winter vacation.
- We have a break (supper) time.

Contents of study

- You will study the same subjects as daytime junior high school. After completing the prescribed curriculum, you will be get a junior high school graduate certificate.
- The teachers, like other junior high schools, have a teacher's license.
- Seiyukan Junior High School has different class hours from daytime junior high school. We study in a special curriculum.
- We will provide Japanese language support to students of foreign nationalities as needed to support students' understanding of the material. (You can't choose subjects, and you can't choose to study only Japanese.)

※ Students study in separate courses, which are unrelated to their grade level. Students study in courses regardless of grade level.
 ※ The available cCourses are Start, Basic, Standard, Challenge, and Japanese, and the learning content differs for each course.
 ※ Students will decide on their course through individual consultations and trial sessions before enrolling.
 ※ Activities : moral education, comprehensive study time, extracurricular activities
