Sapporo Seiyukan Junior High School (public night junior high school)

【FY2026 Admission Information】

There are people who are over the age of compulsory education (15 years old), regardless of nationality, who could not graduate from junior high school for various reasons, or who were not able to learn enough due to reasons such as attendance.

In order for such people to gain a junior high school level of education, Sapporo Seiyukan Junior High School is the first public night junior high school established in Hokkaido.

We are inviting applicants for the 2026 school year.

Sapporo City Board of Education

○ Admission qualification All of the following conditions must be met:



- Those who are over the age of compulsory education (15 years old).
- Those who have not graduated from junior high school, or those who have graduated but have not been able to fully study due to reasons such as issues with attendance (regardless of nationality).
- Those who live in Sapporo City and municipalities that cooperate with Sapporo City.

○ The number of students accepted

- The plan is for about 30 students to be accepted.

○ Contents of study

- You will study the same subjects as daytime junior high school
 - We will provide Japanese language support to students of foreign nationalities as needed to support students' understanding of the material. (You can't choose subjects, and you can't choose to study only Japanese.)
 - After completing the prescribed curriculum, you will be get a junior high school graduate certificate.
- ※The program for each student will be decided thorough consultation to meet his/her needs. Because this is a public junior high school, every student is required to take all subjects. You cannot selectively take only the subjects that you want to take.

○ The school day, learning time

- The school year starts in April and ends in March.
- We study on weekday nights. (From 5:30 pm to 9:00 pm)
- We study 5 days a week.(4 hours a day, 20 hours a week)
Holidays are the same as daytime at junior high schools in Sapporo, such as summer vacation and winter vacation.
- We have a break (supper) time.

○ Expenses

- There is no tuition fee. You can get the textbooks for free.
- About 500 yen a month is required for school life, as teaching materials and paper costs.
There is also a school lunch fee. Event fees occasionally may be required.
- The fee for the school supper is about 300 yen per meal.
- There is a system for support school attendance.

○ Commuting

- You are asked to commute by public transportation.
- If you are unsure of how to use it, please consult the school.

○ What applicants should do by the date of admission

【Flow from application submission to admission permission】

- (1) Submit the application form.
- (2) Consult with the school.
- (3) Submit other documents.
- (4) Confirmation of enrollment



(1) Submit the application form.

- Submit the application form.
- You can submit the application by post, fax or e-mail, or in person at the school.

(2) Consult with the school.

- The school will interview you about how long you were unable to attend junior high school. Through the interview, your qualification to attend the school will be confirmed.
- In contacting the applicant to decide the date and time of the interview, the school will use the order in which the applications are submitted.

(3) Submit other documents.

- Submit your letter of confirmation of admission intention (using the form) and other necessary documents to the school.
- Necessary documents may differ from person to person. At the consultation, we will advise you on what you will need to submit.

(4) Confirmation of enrollment

- A letter that confirms your enrollment will be delivered.

○ Application submission

- If you wish to be enrolled in April 2026, submit the application form by December 25, 2025.
- After that, students can be enrolled from May through October, 2026. We accept applications for enrollment during this period from January 8 through August 21, 2026. Students will be enrolled on the first school day of each month.
- Please note that it will take more than one month to finalize your admission process after we receive your application form.


○ Other
